With the completion of the first phase of construction quickly approaching, you've probably noticed that most of the scaffolding has been removed. Flynn Roofing has doubled its efforts to complete the roof before the Christmas celebrations and more carpenters have been brought on-site to help complete the remaining portion. The new copper roof has dramatically changed the appearance of the Cathedral! Furthermore, since the repairs were made, no water has filtered into the Cathedral during the recent weeks of heavy rain and snowfall. We look forward to seeing the end results of the repairs this upcoming spring.



Results of the Parish Campaign launched September 23, 2012 - Goal \$1,000,000



We are pleased to inform you that since the beginning of the official launch of the campaign this fall, we've received \$237,665 in donations and commitments from parishioners, which accounts for 27% of our goal.

Overall, the Renewal campaign has reached 46% of its goal, with \$ 2,780,471 of its \$ 6,000,000 goal.

News from the City of Winnipeg

On November 22, the St. Boniface Cathedral Parish received a letter from the City of Winnipeg indicating that the historical designating the site of the Cathedral will be discussed during the *Standing Policy Committee on Downtown Development, Heritage and Riverbank Management* meeting on January 8, 2013.

In addition, efforts are on-going with the Mayor and our municipal city councillor Dan Vandal in anticipation of receiving a favourable response to the request for financial support for the Renewal project.
