

City of Winnipeg Contributes \$350,000 towards the Renewal Project



Gerald Labossiere, co-president of the Renewal Campaign and Robert Gabor, member of the heritage committee, presented the Cathedral Renewal project to the City of Winnipeg's Standing Policy Committee on Downtown Development, Heritage and Riverbank Management on April 11th. The committee voted unanimously to pass the recommendation to the Executive Committee. EPC also voted unanimously in favor of the heritage preservation grant on April 17th. 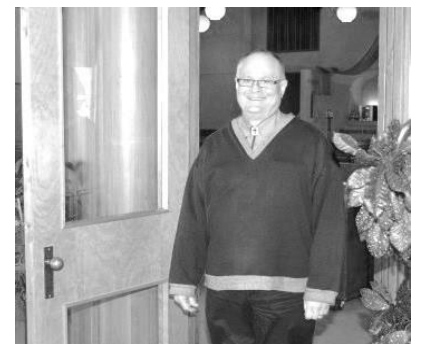
“The St. Boniface Cathedral has become an important icon not only for St. Boniface, but for Winnipeg and the entire province,” said Vandal. “It is important to protect historic sites like these not only to support local development but to make sure our history and our common cultural identity are preserved for future generations.”



Full Steam ahead with Phase II - Focus on usability

Phase 2 of the renovation project will focus primarily on the St. Boniface Cathedral's community hall and the two other rooms in the basement. “Electrical work is urgently required,” expressed Father Marcel Carrière. “But the kitchen and bathrooms are also in need of some work. We would also like to improve the audiovisual and computer equipment to optimize meetings held in these areas.” Other concerns regarding the Cathedral also exist. “The problems of lighting and sound are among our biggest concerns,” continues the clergyman. “These elements really need to be reviewed as they are inadequate. Especially because good lighting can generate a special ambiance, which would be much appreciated.”

A public consultation will take place on May 28th, 2013, following the completion of the architects' conceptual design of the Cathedral's basement. You will all be invited to attend to give your comments and suggestions. We hope to see you there! More details will be available in the next newsletter.
